topped with our house blue cheese dressing.

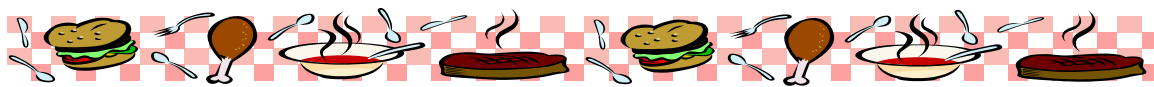
