

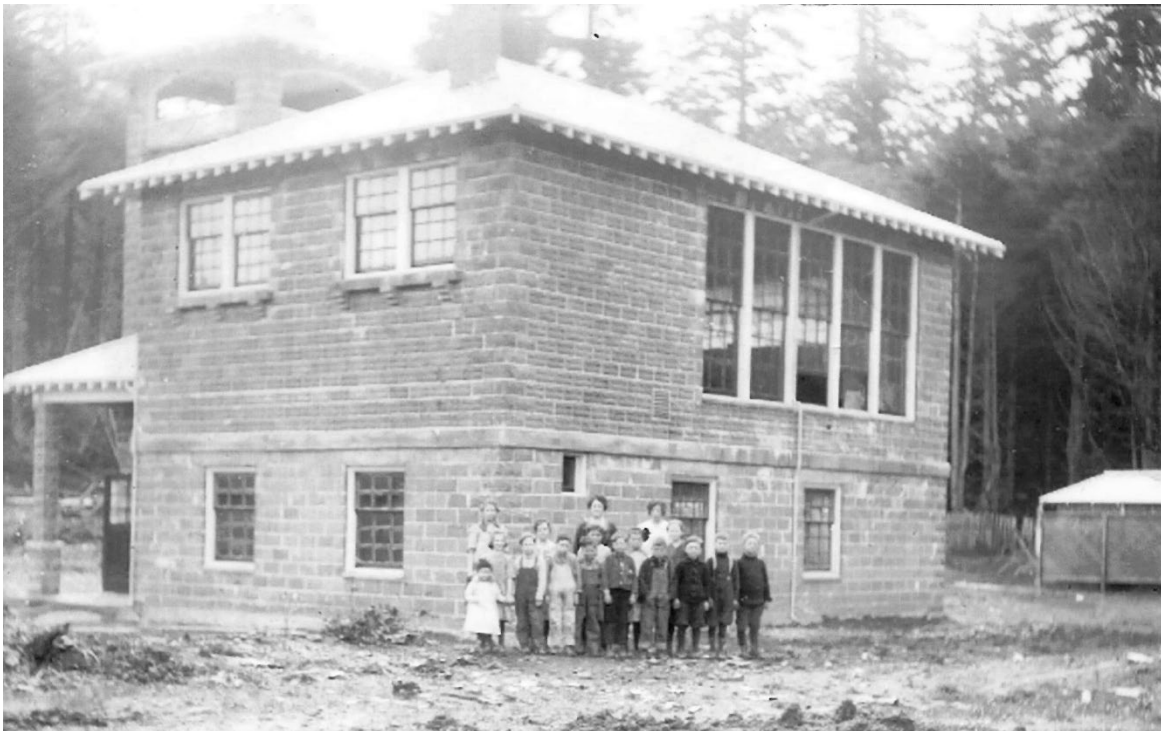
# Footprints Through the Sands of Time

Copalis Beach School, 1912

The Copalis Beach School District #62, was established in part by homesteaders and sea otter hunters Charlie McIntyre of Copalis Beach and Steve Grover from Moclips. The teacher at this school was T.A. Yowell. In 1908, the school received \$101.20 from the county superintendent during the second quarter.

Contractor Peter L. Granstrom also built an identical school on Ocean Beach Road at Newton in 1913 which is now a private residence. This site of the Copalis Beach School is the current location of the Copalis Beach Post Office.
